Curbside composting is the easiest way to reduce the most amount of compostable waste, return nutrients to the soil, reduce our reliance on synthetic fertilizers, and reduce greenhouse gas emissions. Learn more about the top 5 reasons to compost.

How to Turn Your Spoils to Soil

- **1. Line your curbside bin or countertop container.** Use certified compostable liners or brown paper bags when above freezing.
- 2. Fill your bin with raw, cooked, or spoiled food scraps. Include more items than a backyard pile such as bones, napkins, cheese, lobster shells, and much more. See our compost quide for a full list.
- **3. Place your bin on the curb** to be emptied the night before or by 6:00 AM on your pickup day.
- **4. Smile!** You are making good use of your food scraps and helping the environment. While you are smiling, we're mixing, turning, and screening the organics.
- **5. Receive finished compost** in spring 2024.
